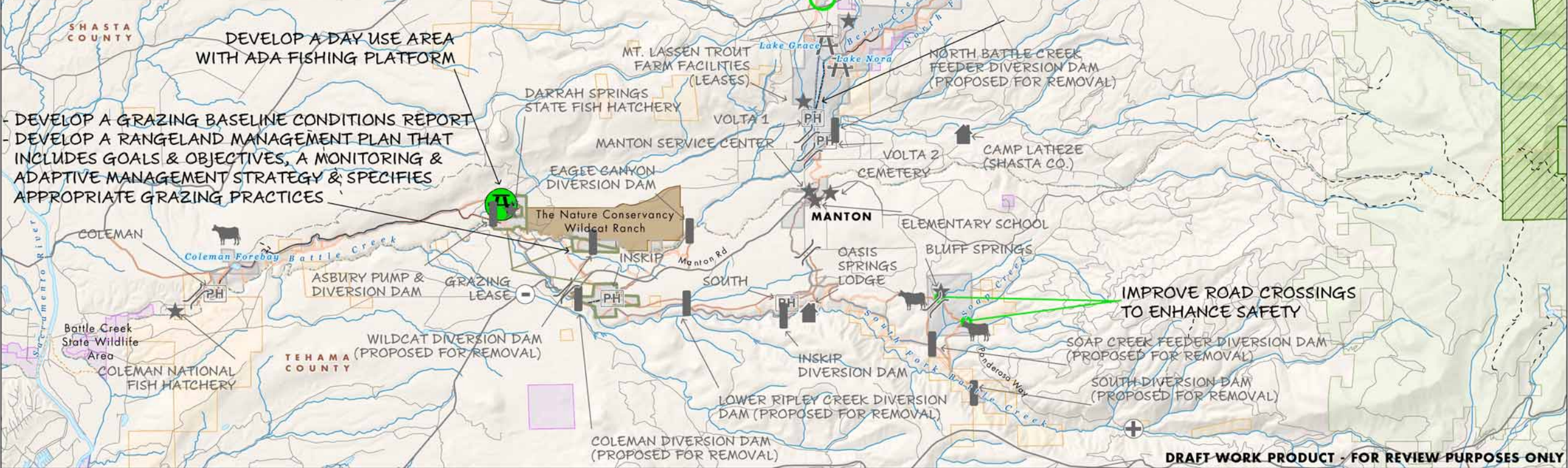


# Battle Creek Planning Unit

- MANAGEMENT ACTIONS:**
- DEVELOP MANAGEMENT PLANS FOR NOXIOUS WEEDS, WILDLIFE & HABITAT, FORESTS, FUELS, FIRE RESPONSE & CULTURAL RESOURCES
  - CONDUCT SURVEYS OUTSIDE THE BATTLE CREEK RESTORATION PROJECT BOUNDARY TO IDENTIFY BIOLOGICAL & CULTURAL RESOURCES & ENABLE THEIR PROTECTION
  - COORDINATE WITH NATIVE AMERICANS & INTERESTED STAKEHOLDERS WHEN CONDUCTING CULTURAL RESOURCE MEASURES
  - COORDINATE WITH THE BATTLE CREEK SALMON & STEELHEAD RESTORATION PROJECT & BATTLE CREEK WATERSHED CONSERVANCY
  - EVALUATE EXISTING TIMBER INVENTORY DATA & SUPPLEMENT AS APPROPRIATE
  - MANAGE PLANTATIONS TO BEST MIMIC FORESTS IN THE NATURAL LANDSCAPE
  - UPDATE THE EXISTING FERC RECREATIONAL USE PLAN
  - ASSESS THE POTENTIAL FOR YOUTH PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES
  - INVENTORY RECREATION USE ON PLANNING UNIT LANDS & EVALUATE NEED/DEMAND FOR ADDITIONAL FACILITIES
  - EVALUATE THE POTENTIAL FOR ADDITIONAL GRAZING OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN THE PLANNING UNIT
